1 To create this dazzling new home in Wildwood, interior designer Suzanne Tullock, Allied ASID, worked with her clients from the ground up. "They love French country," says Tullock. "They wanted European design with a more traditional flair, and we were able to accomplish that."

The island is custom-painted with a chocolate glaze and has a 3-inch granite top. The walls are purposely left understated to allow the cabinetry and the warm green trim to be the focal points. The beautiful natural stone floors are tumbled travertine, and the backsplash features Sonoma tiles with a crackle glaze.

The homeowner has four children and loves to cook. "As a native Californian with frequent visitors, the kitchen is very important," says Tullock. "It is the hub of the home."
